However, these innovations are sooner or later confronted with the realities of commercial manufacturing, manufacturing equipment, material technologies, and processes in the supply chain need to constantly evolve in order to keep up with the demands of patients and healthcare providers. Protecting the intellectual property becomes one of the eye concerns as far as the innovator company is concerned.

The opportunity in biopharmaceuticals is big and growing too rapidly to ignore. Today, biopharmaceuticals generate global revenues of \$163 billion, making up about 20 percent of the pharma market. Many large pharmaceutical companies are shifting their presence to biopharma. In the pharmaceutical and bio-pharmaceutical sectors - where innovation costs are very high, regulatory approval substantially delays market entry and few R&D projects result in marketed drugs - patents are considered an essential factor in protecting competitive advantage. Patents have a role to play for start-ups and university spin-offs in the biomedical field because both rely on protected IP as their main asset in raising capital for development (OECD, 2004). While the debate on patentability of biotechnology inventions continues because of its impact on biomedical research in one side pharmaceutical sector is one of most prominent as well as crucial sector on the other hand vehemently argues for the need of patent protection to protect its investment. This conference aims to impart the knowledge, skill and develop competencies of participants on the area of Pharmaceutical and biotechnology patents. Also, to create awareness on patent search, drafting techniques and the patentability of Pharmaceutical inventions in India. For that, the sessions are generally on the Patentability requirements in Pharma sector, and practical session and the seminar will conclude with a counselling session aimed at clarifying queries of participants at a personal level.
